

Competitive Open Play Rules

Competitive Open Play was created to encourage a more competitive environment for our more serious players. This format is a way for players to rotate in and out and challenge themselves against many different opponents. Players will adhere to the “first off, first in” format and should not sit out for more than 8-10 minutes.

“Winner Stay On” Format

- 1. To begin, put your name on the list.**
- 2. 1st round only – Play to 7 (to honor the first players out)**
- 3. Win and stay on (up to three matches) If you lose, regardless of what court you are on, your team rotates out.**
- 4. If you’re fortunate enough to win three in a row, you take a turn sitting out.**
- 5. First team out, first team in. Teams rotate on ANY court (all courts even, no high or low court).**
- 6. All games are played to the designated score, sudden death, win by 1 point!**
- 7. Games are played to 9 points when total player is 19, 20, 21 or 22**
- 8. Games are played to 11 points when total player is 17 or 18**
